Belmont Stakes Analysis

IRISH WAR CRY (GRAHAM MOTION/RAJIV MARAGH) - Certainly didn't look interested in going a distance in no-excuses fade at the Kentucky Derby and took a pass on the Preakness. But you have to respect the connections of this Curlin off-spring, as well as his performance in the Wood Memorial. With Classic Empire out he could be out on front end midway through the stretch making the race his to lose or win. The strapping chestnut colt was installed as the morning-line choice, but he's a difficult favorite to trust enough to wheel on top. He's talented enough to win this race. Horses with some tactical speed usually excel in this event, and he's a son of stamina influence Curlin, so he may be well-suited to this distance. I had him in the Derby to hit the board, but as mentioned earlier, he faded. Hope my initial analysis was right because I'm going to take a shot with him to make amends and win the Belmont.

PATCH (TODD PLETCHER/TYLER GAFFALIONE) - Another one who never really had a chance in the Churchill Downs train wreck. Hard to tell if the son of Belmont winner Union Rags can run fast enough, never mind long enough. What I like about Patch is that he fits the profile of the kind of horse that should take a step forward in this race. Considering that he only got his career started in January, he projects to continue improving into the second half the season. He showed enough talent to make it into the Kentucky Derby, but he just wasn't fast enough to really distinguish himself racing against the best of his division at conventional distances. However, that may change now that he's stretching out. He is sired by Belmont Stakes winner Union Rags and is out of a dam that is by another Belmont winner, A.P. Indy. There is quality dirt route form running right down through his female family, tracing to the dam of champion filly Banshee Breeze. This distance should be right up his alley and his new rider, John Velazquez, knows how to win this race. We should see Patch produce the best effort of his career thus far.

TAPWRIT (TODD PLETCHER/JLORTIZ) - You have to respect a son of Tapwrit, who produced last two Belmont winners. Was roughed-up in the Kentucky Derby tangle and missed the gate in G2 Blue Grass. Freshened and bred to get the distance. I like him some. 6-1. Tapwrit gives the impression that he should handle added ground, and Tapit has sired the winner of this race in two of the past three years. If he can get back to the form that carried him to victory in the Tampa Bay Derby in March, he figures to be a major factor in this race.

GORMLEY (JOHN SHERRIFFS/V.ESPINOZA) - Another one who looked like he was up to the Kentucky Derby battle for a while, but shrunk down the stretch. Seems to fire every other time. Could this be the moment for the Malibu Moon offspring? He worked out a perfect trip when winning the Santa Anita Derby in his prior start, closing into a fast pace. Before that, he had been a one-dimensional front-runner. With the defection of Classic Empire, he becomes the only Grade 1 winner in this field. Other horses in this race have more convincing 1 1/2-mile pedigrees. That said, he clearly possesses some quality, which is more than can be said about a few of his rivals. He's usable, but I prefer others in the top slots.

LOOKIN AT LEE (S.ASMUSSEN-IRAD ORTIZ) - Son of Lookin at Lucky does it by running late and being around for a piece. Might do same here. This is the kind of horse that many handicappers tend to gravitate toward in the Belmont Stakes. The logic goes: He was making up ground late in the both the Kentucky Derby and Preakness, so it stands to reason that he should finally get there now that he has two extra furlongs to play with. Not so fast. Deep-closing plodders actually have often struggled in the Belmont Stakes, due to the fact that the pace is usually more moderate than in the prior two Triple Crown races. Instead, the Kentucky Derby runner-up looks poised to secure another minor award in this race.

SENIOR INVESTMENT (KEN MCPEEK/CHANNING HILL) - Up for third in the Preakness after shaky start, the Discreetly Mine colt has steadily improved during '17 campaign. The late runner has the chops to be in the mix if not too far back early. Horses like Senior Investment were running on after the race had been decided. He does deserve some credit for producing the best performance of his career in Maryland, when it really counted. However, he's another one with a pedigree that suggests 1 1/2 miles may be a stretch, and it's hard to see the pace of this race totally melting down. A minor award may be his ceiling again.

EPICHARIS (K.HAGIWARA/CHRISTOPHE LEMAIRE) - The high-profile new shooter has won four of five, the lone defeat at the wire to Thunder Snow in the \$2 million UAE Derby. He's a Sunday Silence, so might like the distance. But Japan is not the U.S.A. when it comes to competition. Tough to get too excited about at these odds. 4-1. There are stamina influences throughout Epicharis's pedigree, tracing to his grandsire, Sunday Silence, and his damsire, Carnegie, who was himself a winner of the 12-furlong Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. His dam, Stapes Mitsuko, produced a half-sibling that won a Group 3 race at 10 furlongs and was second in a prestigious Group 2 going 11 furlongs. Epicharis tends to be forwardly placed in his races, but he doesn't need the lead, which should allow him to work out a decent stalking trip in this event. I think he stacks up well against this mediocre group of U.S. 3-year-olds. Health may be a concern and I'm very patriotic and just DO NOT bet non US based horses. If he hits the board my stubborness will cost me.

With Classic Empire out, this has become a very difficult race to finalize a wagering methodology. Nevertheless, my plays are:

\$1 Exacta Box: 2,7,12 = \$6 plus \$1 Exacta 7,12 with 2,3,7,12 = \$6 Total Exacta Play = \$12

\$1 Trifecta Box 2,7,12= \$6 plus \$1 Trifecta 2,7,12 with 2,3,6,7,12 with 2,3,6,7,8,4,12 = \$60 Total Trifecta Play = \$66

\$1Superfecta Box 2.3.7.12 = \$24 - Total Bets = \$102 Total Cashed on Belmont Stakes: \$2577.60 based on \$1 Wagers

Of course, you choose how to bet based upon your budget. Depending where you're betting, you most likely should be able to bet 50 cent trifecta tickets and cut the cost of those plays in half down to \$33 and a total of \$51. For all you \$2194 trifecta winners who bought my Preakness tip sheet, I say what do you have to lose ... send it in. Note that Dennis plays much more than \$1 tickets.
